

## **Notice to all Landowners and Farmers:**

For reasons of liability, it is necessary for Clark County to enforce the state laws that protect the county right-of-ways. Anyone who compromises the roadway or its right-of-ways can be charged, based on SDCL 31-32-7 and other state laws.

Clark County residents are reminded they cannot leave bales in the right-of-way of county and township roads. Bales in the right-of-way cause blind spots and create problems for equipment operators. The right-of-way is designed for traffic safety and should be kept clear of obstructions.

This law will be strictly enforced and Clark County Officials ask for your cooperation in this matter.
